**Background**


On June 14, 2013, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) filed a Notice of Charges Seeking Rescission, Restitution, Civil Money Penalties, and Other Legal and Equitable Relief (Notice of Charges) in this proceeding. On June 18, 2013, pursuant to the Interagency Agreement between the CFPB and the Office of Administrative Law Judges of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), the CFPB requested that an SEC Administrative Law Judge be assigned to preside at the hearing in Louisville, Kentucky, on August 12, 2013, at 9:00 a.m. EDT and to prepare a recommended decision as called for in Section 400 of the CFPB's Rules of Practice. See 12 C.F.R. § 1081.400.

**Order**

Administrative Law Judge Brenda P. Murray is assigned to the proceeding.

The Notice of Charges requires 3D Resorts-Bluegrass, LLC, to file an answer within fourteen days of being served with the Notice of Charges. See 12 C.F.R. § 1081.201. On condition that service is accomplished, a telephonic scheduling conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. EDT on Tuesday, July 2, 2013, pursuant to Rule 203 of the CFPB's Rules of Practice.
