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**[PROPOSED] ORDER REGARDING MOTION IN LIMINE TO STRIKE THE BUREAU’S CLAIMS FOR REMEDIES OTHER THAN INJUNCTIVE RELIEF FOR CONDUCT PRIOR TO JULY 21, 2011**

This matter is before the undersigned hearing officer on the Motion in Limine of Respondents to strike the Bureau’s claims for remedies other than injunctive relief for conduct prior to July 21, 2011. The matter, having been fully briefed by the Parties, and being fully advised in the premises, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

The Motion in Limine is granted. All claims for remedies other than injunction are stricken to the extent they seek to redress alleged conduct prior to July 21, 2011.

It is further ORDERED that Enforcement Counsel shall SHOW CAUSE within 7 days why the Bureau’s claim for injunction should not be stricken, since there is no allegation that the asserted conduct is ongoing or is likely to resume.
