On January 29, 2014, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau filed a Notice of Charges Seeking Disgorgement, Other Equitable Relief, and Civil Money Penalty. The hearing took place over nine days in Philadelphia, PA, between March 24 and June 4, 2014.

On August 1, 2014, I granted in part the Office of Enforcement's Motion to Amend the Protective Order and to Unseal "Confidential" Material. Document 176. That Order modified the first sentence of Paragraph 8 of Attachment A of the February 28, 2014, Protective Order (Document 48). It also required all parties to confer to determine what should be unsealed pursuant to the Order, and urged the parties to agree to a timeframe for reviewing materials previously designated as Confidential Information for redesignation.

In line with my August 1, 2014, Order, remaining Confidential Information must eventually be unsealed. I ORDER that the parties jointly file a report updating me on the steps taken to date to comply with the August 1, 2014, Order, and providing a timeline for the unsealing of remaining Confidential Information after the redesignation process is complete. *See* 12 C.F.R. § 1081.104(b)(5), (14). This joint report must be filed no later than September 12, 2014.
