On July 8, 2016, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (Bureau) submitted a Motion to Withdraw Count IV of the Notice of Charges (Motion). Count IV is a claim for alleged unfair practices in violation of the Consumer Financial Protection Act. At the time of the Bureau's Motion, Respondents did not consent to the requested withdrawal of Count IV.

Subsequently, on July 11, 2016, the Bureau notified the undersigned that it was withdrawing its previous Motion. In its place, the Bureau filed a Stipulated Motion to Withdraw Count IV with Prejudice (Stipulated Motion). The Bureau stated in the Stipulated Motion that "after further consideration Respondents have stated that they do not object to this motion." Therefore, for good cause shown and in the interests of judicial economy and narrowing the issues for trial, the Stipulated Motion is **GRANTED**.

Count IV of the Notice of Charges is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
