

On June 14, 2013, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) filed a Notice of Charges Seeking Rescission, Restitution, Civil Money Penalties, and Other Legal and Equitable Relief alleging that 3D Resorts-Bluegrass, LLC (3D Resorts-Bluegrass), violated various provisions of the Interstate Land Sales Full Disclosure Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1701-1720. 3D Resorts-Bluegrass filed a petition under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court, Western District of Texas, on November 16, 2011, 3D Resorts-Bluegrass, LLC, No. 11-5401. The proceeding was transferred to the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Kentucky, No. 11-4159, and converted to a Chapter 11 proceeding on December 8, 2011.

A hearing is scheduled to begin tomorrow, August 14, 2013, in Louisville, Kentucky. Last evening in a phone call followed up this morning with a Joint Request to Continue Hearing, the parties informed my Office that they are engaged in settlement discussions and requested that the hearing be postponed until next Monday.

Order

Consistent with CFPB Rule of Practice 115(b), for good cause shown, I GRANT the request and POSTPONE the hearing to Monday, August 19, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. EDT in Room 440, United States Tax Court, Gene Snyder Courthouse-Custom House, 601 West Broadway, Louisville, Kentucky.
