On December 5, 2016, Respondents Integrity Advance, LLC, and James R. Carnes filed a motion seeking an extension to the length of its reply brief. Pursuant to Bureau rules, reply briefs are limited to 15 pages. Respondents request that they be permitted to file a 20-page reply. Bureau Enforcement counsel oppose that request. I have decided to grant Respondents' request. Further, even though Enforcement counsel oppose Respondents' request, I have decided, in the interest of fairness, that Enforcement counsel may also file a 20-page reply brief.

For the reasons set forth above, I GRANT Respondents' Motion for Leave to Exceed the Page Limit for Respondents' Reply Brief. I further GRANT Enforcement counsel a five-page extension of their reply brief. Accordingly, both parties may file reply briefs not to exceed 20 pages in length.
