BUREAU'S RESPONSE TO RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR WITNESS STATEMENTS

On December 14, 2015, Respondents filed a motion under 12 C.F.R. § 1081.207 to compel the Bureau to "produce for inspection and copying any statement of any person called or to be called as a witness." The rule further specifies that this disclosure obligation is coextensive with what would be required of the government under the Jencks Act (18 U.S.C. § 3500) in a criminal proceeding.

The Office of Enforcement already has produced all transcripts of hearings conducted during the investigation. At this time, the Bureau has not determined who it will call as witnesses during a hearing in the above-captioned matter. As a result, it currently does not have any material responsive to Respondents' motion. During the scheduling conference, the parties discussed requiring the identification of witnesses by May 27, 2016. Assuming this Court orders identification by that date, the Bureau

respectfully requests that this Court order production of any Rule 207 material by the same date.
