RESPONDENTS' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

Pursuant to 12 C.F.R. §1081.119, Respondents Integrity Advance, LLC and James R. Carnes (collectively "Respondents"), respectfully move the Court for a Protective Order to redact the personal home addresses of Respondent James R. Carnes and two third parties – who are unrelated to this matter – contained in the Certificate of Service of the Notice of Charges ("the Notice Certificate") dated November 19, 2015. Good cause exists to grant the requested Protective Order, as these addresses constitute the personally identifiable information of Mr. Carnes and two third parties, the public disclosure of which will result in an invasion of the privacy of Mr. Carnes and the third parties. In further support of this Motion, Respondents state as follows:

1. On November 18, 2015, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (the "Bureau") filed the Notice of Charges.

2. On November 19, 2015, the Bureau filed the Notice Certificate.

3. The Notice Certificate states that the Notice of Charges was served on Integrity Advance and Mr. Carnes by sending copies to four different addresses, one of which is Mr. Carnes personal residence and two of which are the addresses of two third parties' personal residences.

4. Accordingly, Respondents respectfully request that all three addresses appearing under the name James R. Carnes in the Notice Certificate be redacted before the Notice Certificate is docketed on the Office of Administrative Adjudication (OAA) website.

5. Pursuant to 12 C.F.R. §1081.112(f), a complete, sealed copy of the Notice Certificate is attached as Exhibit A and a redacted copy of the Notice Certificate is attached as Exhibit B.

6. No party will be prejudiced by the requested protective order.

7. The Bureau does not oppose the requested protective order.

WHEREFORE, Respondents respectfully request that the aforementioned addresses be redacted from the Notice Certificate before it is docketed on the OAA website.
