

**ORDER TERMINATING THE
CONSENT ORDER**

With the consent of Bank of America, N.A. and FIA Card Services, N.A., by and through its Board of Directors, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (Bureau) issued a Consent Order on April 9, 2014, for violations of Section 1053 and 1055, 12 USC 5563 and 5565, in connection with its the billing and administration of credit card add-on (CCAO) products.

To date, the Bank has fulfilled its obligations under the Consent Order, including, among other things, providing redress to affected consumers. The Bank paid a civil money penalty of \$20 million. In addition, the Bank ceased the marketing and sale of all CCAO products.

Accordingly, under Paragraph 85 of the Consent Order the Bureau directs that the Consent Order be, and it hereby is, TERMINATED this 4th day of January, 2017.
