CFPB v. Meracord- Case No. 3:13-cv-05871

(Matter Closed)

Background:

The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, or CFPB, filed a civil action against Meracord LLC. The CFPB alleged that the defendant violated the Telemarketing Sales Rule (TSR), and sections of the Consumer Financial protection Act of 2010. These laws prohibit unfair, deceptive, or abusive acts or practices and protect distressed consumers from mortgage and debt relief scams.
