On January 24, 2020 I issued an order directing the parties to file a *Joint Proposed Schedule* by February 6, 2020. On February 6, 2020, the parties filed a *Joint Proposed Schedule* in which they stated that they have been unable to agree on a proposed schedule. In the document, Respondents indicated their intent to file a motion to dismiss on grounds that the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (“CFPB”) is unconstitutional because it violates the separation of powers and a motion to stay proceedings, pending the Supreme Court’s decision on this issue in *Seila Law LLC v. CFPB*.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, the parties will adhere to the following schedule:

1. Respondents will file their motion to dismiss on the grounds that the CFPB is unconstitutional because it violates the separation of powers, their motion to stay the proceedings, and accompanying brief by **February 19, 2020**.
2. Enforcement Counsel will file their response by **March 4, 2020**.
3. Respondents will file their reply by **March 10, 2020**.
