# Playing a business game


When you're an entrepreneur, unexpected things can happen that affect your business. Understanding some of the ups and downs of running a business can help you think about whether you'd like to be an entrepreneur.

#### Instructions

- 1 Review the game directions.
- 2 While playing the game with a partner, be sure to use the "Toy store income tracker" to write down the amounts you add or subtract.
- 3 Answer the reflection question.

### Game directions

- 1. Place the toy store game cards in a single stack face down in front of you.
- 2. Each player starts with \$250.
- 3. You'll take turns drawing a card.
- 4. Take a card from the top of the deck and read it aloud.
- 5. On the "Toy store income tracker" below, write the amount the card says you should add (+) or subtract (-).
- 6. Calculate a new balance each time you add (+) or subtract (-) an amount.
- 7. The game ends after all the cards have been drawn.
- 8. The player with the most money at the end of the game wins.
