Research charitable organizations

Use the guidance below to do research online about a local charitable organization.

- Search the Combined Federal Campaign website at https://cfcgiving.opm.gov/offerings for a cause you care about.
 - Be sure to include the name of your city or state in your search so you can find local charities.
 - You can refine your results by searching for a keyword like youth, animals, or education.
- Select a charity.
- Check out the charity's website and think about these questions:
 - Does it give information about the programs you want to support or how it uses donations?
 - How much of your donation will go directly to support the programs you care about?



- If you can't find detailed information about a charity's mission and programs, be suspicious.
- If you have time, you can also use CharityWatch at https://www.charitywatch.org/ or Charity Navigator at https://www.charitynavigator.org/ to help you find background information on the charity you chose.
