The Office of Minority and Women Inclusion (OMWI) is here to help you find the right opportunity to do business with the Bureau. You may know that the Bureau has a congressional mandate to promote the utilization of minority-owned, women-owned, and small businesses in all our procurement and business practices. We accomplish this by emphasizing transparency and clear communication with our vendor partners. OMWI developed a 3-step process for businesses to follow when seeking new opportunities:

1. **Review procurement announcements:** The CFPB publishes its upcoming procurement needs regularly. Visit [Doing Business with the CFPB](#) to learn more about the Bureau's needs for goods and services.
2. **Match your capabilities:** When new opportunities post, vendors should match their business capabilities, including NAICS codes and acquisition strategy, to CFPB's requirements forecast:

3. **Communicate with Bureau:** If your capabilities match with a CFPB opportunity, please email OMWI_SupplierDiversity@cfpb.gov. The OMWI office will compile a list of interested vendors and distribute it to the Contracting Officer (CO) assigned to each specific opportunity.
