	ORDER TERMINATING THE CONSENT ORDER
Planet Home Lending, LLC	**

With the consent of Planet Home Lending, LLC (Respondent) and through its Executive Vice President, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (Bureau) issued a Consent Order on January 31, 2017, for improperly accepting a thing of value in exchange for referrals, in violation of Section 8(a) of the Real Estate Settlement Procedures Act, 12 U.S.C. § 2607(a), and its implementing regulation, Regulation X, 12 C.F.R. part 1024 (collectively, RESPA); and obtaining and using credit reporting information for unauthorized purposes, in violation of Section 604(f) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1681b(f).

To this date, Respondent has fulfilled several obligations under the Consent Order, including, among other things, implementing the required Redress Plan,

paying consumer redress of \$265,000, and changing business practices in light of the violations identified in the Consent Order.

Pursuant to its authority under 12 U.S.C. § 5563(b)(3), the Bureau hereby terminates the January 31, 2017 Consent Order.

Accordingly, under Paragraph 51 of the Consent Order, the Bureau directs that the Consent Order be, and hereby is, terminated this ______ day of September 2025.
